1.	<p>Disaster Planning Committee – Gary Hebdon, Chair. Guest Michelle Roache, Deputy Director of LACACC (Small Animal Control), Director. Marsha Mayes, Karen Stephan, Linda Horrell (Equine) and Los Angeles County Fire Dept/Community Service Rep Stephanie English and Chief .</p> <p>Recent Briggs Fire Discussion – communication between small animal control and animal rescue operations for animal evacuation needs. Stephanie English – Planning and training, important but chaos still exists during a crises. New Captain Fire St.#81 – Captain Robinson introduced his crew. New Assistant Fire Chief Bill Nickham, experienced in emergencies and fires, introduced and spoke about Crown/ Briggs fire, describing the Command Center and how Fire Personnel operate: first line of defense - stop fire from joining the other fire and contain it into region without heavy brush. Burned 530 acres, multiagency resources assisted. Road blocked the corridors, hard closure because they didn't know challenges. Did not issue evacuation orders for either animal shelter during the Crown fire. Cause of both fires 5 or 6 minutes apart and 2 others within an hour concerned about arson. Briggs spontaneous ignition. Straw/archery bale. Crown fire started in Agua Dulce, deemed to be unintentional, metal spark into grass. 1<sup>st</sup> Captain: names incident, mostly geographic. Crown fire started on vacant property, Animals: large population they usually recommend shelter in place. Or evacuation plan that you have time to enact. Michelle Roache described Fire Dept. Duties. Large animal usually Pierce College and AV Fairgrounds. A dedicated Horse team helps during fires. During Annual Kennel Inspections, Animal evacuations are discussed. Most problems arise with unpermitted facilities Animal shelters are a last resort – can't take them. She was on the phone with Brittany Foundation assisting. Didn't hear from Villalobos during their evacuation. Circle of neighbors can develop a phone tree. And your neighbors look out for your neighbors. They can help evacuate. Does not work to have a private organization to evac because they will close the roads and not let anyone through. Animal control has evac teams that evac animals to safety. There is an AD volunteer equine evac team that works with Fire. Develop a Plan. Plan with your neighbors. KCAL9.com puts live feed on the internet re: fires. Numerous public sites will text your phone immediately when there is a fire.</p> <p><b><u>Suggested a further meeting with Disaster Committee for Community Plan regarding animals and evacuation, to be Agendized.</u></b></p>

He says he has a permit to keep bees. Neighbors are here to discuss. Not willing to work with the neighbors. Hoping the Town Council can put it on agenda. Grossly impacting his lifestyle. Kids are allergic. He's been doing this for two years, 27 hives, wasn't bad till this year, he keeps adding bees. Horse water, pigs, people have been stung. Chicken feeder, chickens won't eat. It's gotten really bad. He doesn't live on the property. Bees could be Africanized. LC says town council can't get involved in a dispute between neighbors. Must be some measures that are mandated.
