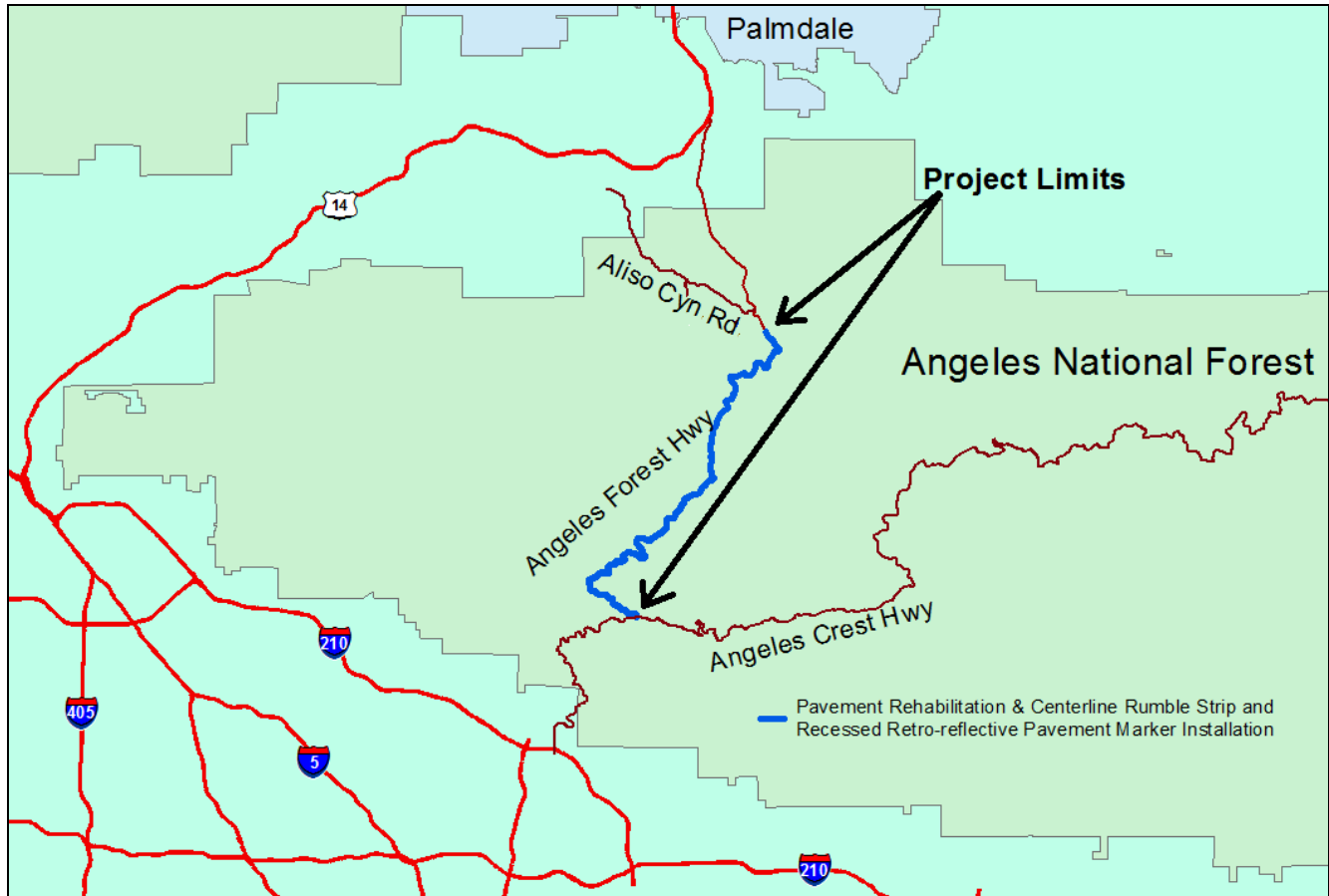

Fact Sheet

Project

Limits: From Angeles Crest Highway to about 1-mile s/o Aliso Canyon Rd (16.4 miles)

Scope: Roadwork on Angeles Forest Highway generally consists of pavement overlays; centerline rumble strip and recessed retro-reflective pavement marker installations; and intermittent guardrail replacement.



Trucks

- **Trips:** Up to 50-60 trucks per day (100-120 round trips) during construction; delivering pavement mix
- **Haul Route:** Irwindale – 210 Fwy – Angeles Crest Hwy (SR-2) – Angeles Forest Hwy
- **Truck Restrictions** (on both Angeles Crest Hwy and Angeles Forest Hwy)

No trucks with 3-axles or more, or >4.5 tons. Construction vehicles are exempt on AFH. Specified commercial vehicles making deliveries are exempt on ACH.

Schedule

- Construction is anticipated to start in late April or early May and continue through October 2015. Some preparation activities have already begun.
- Hours of construction: Mon-Fri, 7:30 am to 4 pm
- One lane of traffic will remain open at all times, and pilot cars will be used.
- Delays of up to 30-minutes can be expected.
